

Dear Homeowners of the Oak Lane/Folkestone Area

As you can see, Folkestone Street from N 145<sup>th</sup> to N 148<sup>th</sup> is being reconstructed this summer. Residents along the street will need to park on Oak Lane or on Folkestone where there is no construction.

The east end of Oak Lane, from East Oak Lane Circle to Folkestone, has **no parking** on the east side of Oak Lane. On the west side of Oak Lane, from West Oak Lane Circle to Folkestone, also has **no parking** on the west side of Oak Lane. These restrictions are in place to accommodate Fire and Rescue services, garbage trucks and mail delivery.

Once Phase 1 (east side) of Folkestone is complete, Phase 2 (west side) will be torn out. Vehicles will be parking on the west side of Oak Lane near West Oak Lane Circle. The east side of Oak lane will then return more to normal as those residents will be able to have access to their driveways on the east side of Folkestone.

The construction company Constructors has allowed themselves an 11-week construction schedule to complete **both** Phase 1 and Phase 2 of this project; this includes unforeseen delays and average rainfall events. Their goal is to have the project done sooner than 11 weeks, with some of the construction activities being done with open traffic such as sprinkler repair and grass and dirt backfilling.
